Aim

Promote wellbeing through supporting and facilitating the development of Healthy Universities across the region by:

- Sharing information, ideas, experience and good practice
- Developing and promoting models of good practice
- Contributing to national developments
- Promoting collaborative working towards new initiatives

Membership

The Yorkshire and Humber Healthy Universities Network will be chaired by the Yorkshire and Humber Teaching Public Health Network (YHTPHN) and will be made up of representatives from:

- Universities from Yorkshire and Humber region
- Sport England
- Primary Care Trusts
- National Union of Students
- Trade Unions
- Local Authorities

Operations

Meetings will be held quarterly in the first instance, to be reviewed after 12 months, with YHTPHN providing secretariat support.

YHTPHN will actively engage with national developments, represent the region at meetings and ensure network members are kept informed of progress.

An online resource will be made available as part of the YHTPHN website to aid communication.
